Then select six elements that best suit your training needs from the list below (please note that some elements will cost more than others).

- High low high (Mohawk Walk)
- Bosons chair
- Swinging tyres
- Multi vines
- Loose post mans
- Fixed post mans
- Traverse wall
- Traverse net
- Team platform
- Wobbly log
- Indie Bridge
- Burma bridge
- Kitten crawl

Optional elements

In addition to the standard course above you can add the following isolated:

- Wild wozy
- Spiders web
- All aboard swing
- Trust fall platforms
- Peg pole wall
- Friction log
- Parallel wires
- Tin corrugate or sail shade Roof
- Permanent fencing around the site

Course Dimensions

- Minimum space required - 14m x 14metres
- Hex course diameter - 10metres
- Height - 4.2metres
- Pole Depth - 1.5metres
- Build Time - 5 to 10 days depending on requirements

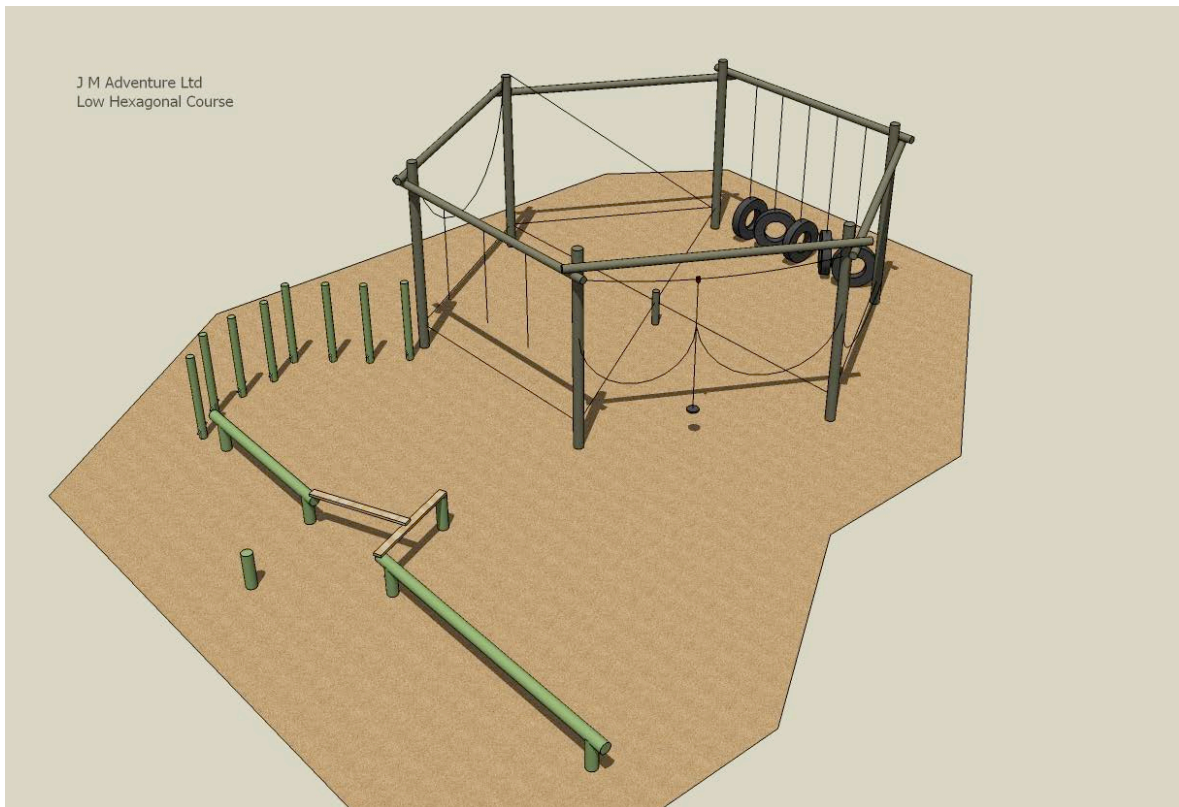
